






An elephant's nose is called a trunk. A trunk is very strong. It is so strong that it can carry big things. An elephant brings food to its mouth with its trunk. African elephants have very large ears. Some people think their ears look like the map of Africa. The ears of the Asian elephant are much smaller than those of African elephants and look a bit like the shape of India. An elephant has two tusks. Tusks are teeth. People hunt them for their tusks.



There are around five hundred thousand African elephants in the forest. But only twenty-five years ago, there were more than one million. That means in twenty-five years, half the elephants that lived, have died.

Asian elephants are even more endangered than African elephants. There are less than 50,000 alive because hunters kill them and people destroy the forests where they live. The number of elephants will increase in the future if people take more care of them and protect their natural homes.
